# DEWITT YMCA

## Hours of Operation

DeWitt Branch specialty camps run from 8:30am to 11:30am, Monday through Friday. **There will be a \$10 fee charged per occurrence if you're six or more minutes late for pickup.**

## Lunch Bunch Option

Need your camper to stay a little longer at camp? Have your child participate in our Lunch Bunch option from 11:30am-1:00pm for only \$6 per day per child. This staff supervised lunch break includes large group games. Children need to bring a non-perishable lunch and drink with them. Children must be pre-registered to participate. Fee: \$6/day/child.

## Financial Assistance

Partial scholarships for camp are available for families who qualify as long as funds are available. Assistance forms must accompany the camp registration to be considered. ## Cancellations, Changes & Refunds

Cancellations received 14 days before the affected session receive a refund less a \$25 processing fee. Refunds or transfers requested after this time require a medical certificate. Once the session begins, no refunds or credits are made. There will be a \$10 fee to switch from one week of camp to another.

## Highest Quality Staff

Staff members are highly trained and are required to undergo criminal history checks along with drug screenings. Each staff member is certified in CPR, First Aid and Child Abuse Prevention. In addition, they have prior experience working with children in a group setting.

## How to Register

Summer programs fill quickly; early registration is recommended and encouraged. Registration is available online, by phone, in person, by mail or fax. Only applications which are completed in full, signed and accompanied by the appropriate fees will be processed. Online and fax registrations require payment by credit card. Every camper will be required to have a health form and concussion form on file one week prior to checking in. These are located at the front desk or online. Any medication must be in its original container and turned in at check in to the camp director.

## Join us for Camp Day/Healthy Kids Day

Join us, Saturday, April 25<sup>th</sup> from 9:30 am-12:00 pm at the DeWitt YMCA we will have games for the kids, registration specials and the directors will be available to answer any questions. Camp Pa Wa Pi's 400' Zip Line will be open from 1:00pm-3:00pm, for ages 6 and up for our first annual "Send a Kid to Camp" event! Rides are free, and donations are encouraged. Tour camp and meet our staff in the afternoon.

## Sports Sampler (Ages 6-12)
